Located in Chautauqua Park. Features a leisure pool, diving area, lap swimming, lazy river, drop slide, family slide and deck sprays.

Community theatre owned by the Mitchell County Foundation. Open seven days a week.

Beloit Area Concert Series
Municipal Building785-738-2980
Four profession concerts hosted a year, with a variety of instrumental and vocal talents.

Little Red Schoolhouse - “Lil’ Red”
Roadside Park Hwy 24 & 9785-738-2717
Historical 1940’s one-room school house. Call for tours.

St. John’s Catholic Church
701 E. Court.....785-738-2851
Historic “Old World” architecture, built from 1901-1904 of native limestone. Two massive towers visible on the skyline.

Presbyterian Church & Liberty Bell
321 E. Main St.....785-738-3091
Historical 1878, native limestone church. In 1951 one of only six replica “Liberty Bell” bells cast for the 1876 U.S. Centennial was placed in the bell tower.

Mitchell County Historical Society & Museum and Farmer’s Museum
1915 N. Independence785-738-5355
Historical Society incorporated in 1971. Museum in existence since 1880. Located in “old Nurse’s home” and houses a variety of exhibits. Open M, T & Th.

Porter House Apartments – Historic Porter Hotel
209 E. Main St, #104.....785-738-9900
Listed on the National Register of Historic Sites, built in 1939. Lobby open to public.

Perdue House – Mitchell County Regional Medical Foundation
422 W. 8th St.785-738-9493
National Registry of Historic Sites. Jane Perdue supported herself in the 1920’s & ‘30’s with a tea room hosted in the Perdue House.

Mitchell County Courthouse
111 S. Hersey785-738-3652
Listed on National Register of Historic places. Built of native limestone in 1901. Houses county offices.

Brown Homestead Marker
About four miles East of Beloit on Asherville Rd. One of the first homesteads in Mitchell County. Large Historical marker describes the farm.

CAWKER CITY
Local Talent Shop
713 Wisconsin St.785-781-4750
A shop highlighting local artists and crafters. Also has a wide array of Ball of Twine memorabilia.

Largest Ball of Sisal Twine
Hwy 24, middle of Cawker City785-781-4470
Outdoor venue, started in 1953 by farmer, Frank Stoeber. Call ahead to add twine to the ball. As of August, 2024, the ball weighs 28,202 lbs and is 8,623,041 ft. of sisal twine.

Hesperian Library & Museum
721 Lake Drive
National Register of Historic Places. First building built by a Woman’s Club in Kansas. Special items are geological specimens & book signed by Susan B. Anthony.

Oldest Pipe Organ in Kansas
At Methodist Church, 608 Lake Drive
Built in 1886 by Pilcher’s Sons of Louisville, Kentucky. Built for the congregational church in Kinsley, Kansas, and the only organ in Kansas west of Emporia at that time.

GLEN ELDER
Glen Elder Swimming Pool
100 N. Market St.....785-454-3298
Open Memorial Day to Labor Day, weather permitting. Diving board and kids slide.

Ernie Norris Castle Service Station
(now private property) at 100 S. Market St.
Acting on a dream from serving in the military during WWI, in 1926, Ernie Norris built a service station that resembled a castle he’d seen in Luxemburg.

Statue of Liberty in City Park
Wilson Neff Park, City Square..... 785-545-3345 (City Hall)
Symbolic statue in center of park, donated in 1950 by Emily Slaven.

National Peace Pole in City Park
Wilson Neff Park, City Square..... 785-545-3345 (City Hall)
North side of park. Peace Pole marks Kansas’ 150-year observance in honor of Post Civil War settlement and search for peace.

Stortz Stop ‘N Shop & Big Bobber
129 S. Mill St785-282-0630
Quick stop and shop for snacks and refreshments in Glen Elder on the city square. Hunting, fishing and lake gear available and some antiques.

Glen Elder State Park

Located just west of the city of Glen Elder, S. of US-24/K-9 & KS 128 intersection. Glen Elder Reservoir is one of KS largest lakes at 12,500 acres and unlimited recreational opportunities.

Glen Elder State Park Waconda Springs Replica & Waconda Springs Visitor & Education Center
Commemorating the history of the Waconda Mineral Springs as a holy site for Native Americans and the later use of the Springs for a Hotel and Health Spa, visitors can walk to the Waconda Springs Replica and view history at the museum/visitor center.

Tipton Heritage Museum

Built in 1877 and is one of the original commercial buildings in town. Houses artifacts of the community and region.

One hundred year old Catholic high school, still in operation.

St. Boniface Church Grotto
308 Gambrinus785-373-4455
Grotto built in 1934 from rocks in the surrounding Blue Hills and those brought by Father Charles Menig from the Lourdes, France area.

Tipton Grocery & Deli
601 Main St.....785-373-4125
Old Fashioned Grocery Store with Deli counter and multiple items.

HUNTER
The Bank
First Street in Hunter785-534-9508
Historical building from 1917, now used as a Lodge.

SCOTTSVILLE
The Bank Building
2323 Commercial Ave., Scottsville
Historical, built in 1916; now a private business.

ASHERVILLE
Asherville Cemetery
1 mile N. & 1 mile East of Asherville
First Mitchell County African American settler buried here.

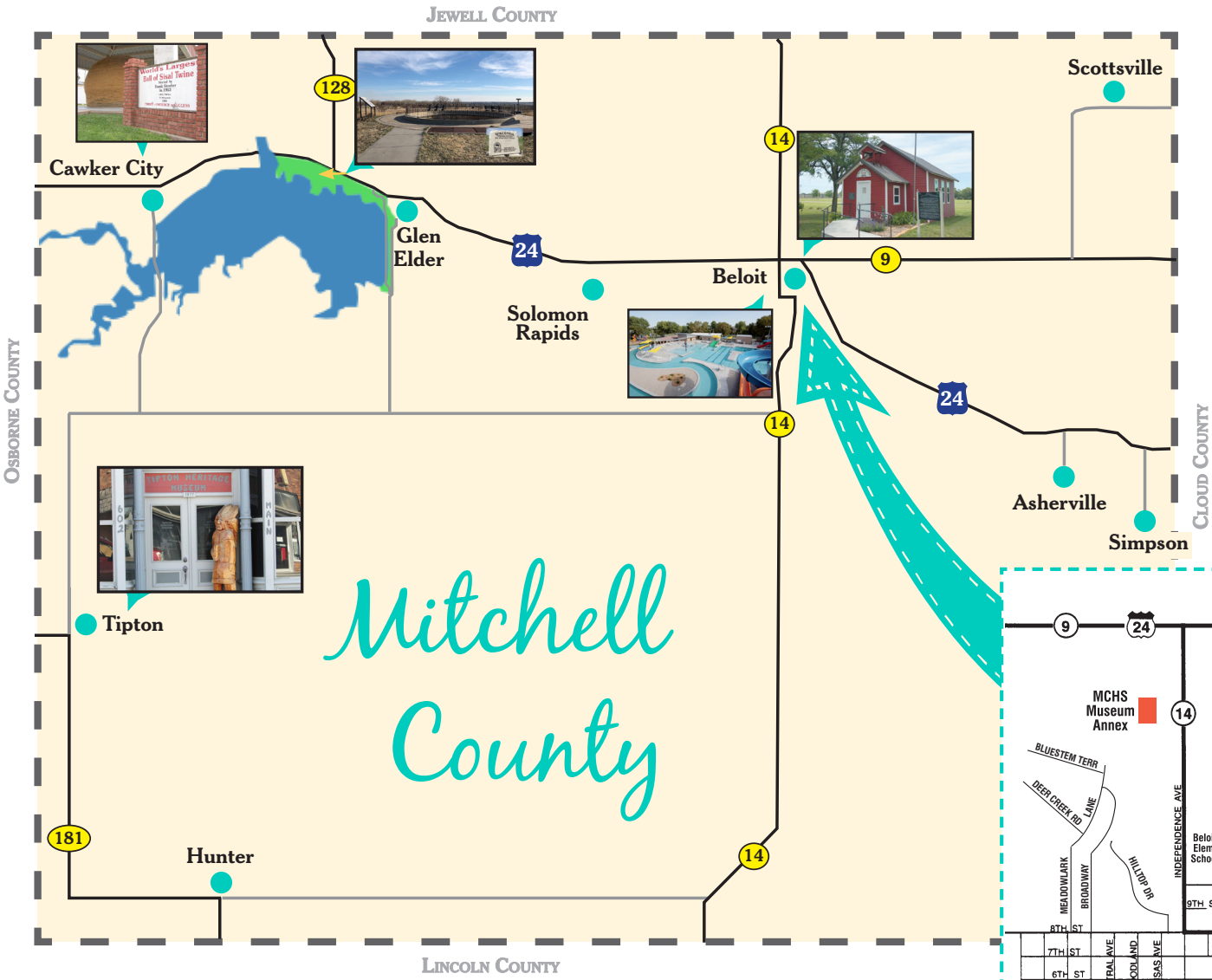
